

Sleek Window Lisulation

Most people buy window insulation more on the basis of looks han on thermal performance. If you like the look of a pleated fabric shade and equire only moderate thermal performance, take a look at Thermal Technology Corporation's new Micropleat shade. The shade, due out soon, is made from a translucent polyester fabric and will be available in 10 "designer" colors.

Micropleat has a honeycomb configuration like its parent product Thermocell, but is only one-inch thick, compared with Thermocell's two inch dimension. Preliminary testing rates the new window insulation at R-3 over single glass (R-3.5 with edge seals). about mercent better than the pleated shade with which it will compete. While it beats pleated shades on R-values, Micropleat will compete head on with pleated shades for cost. The final cost? Probably about \$7 per square foot.
