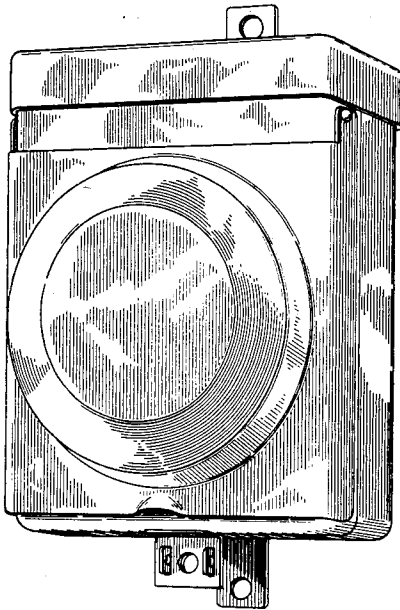

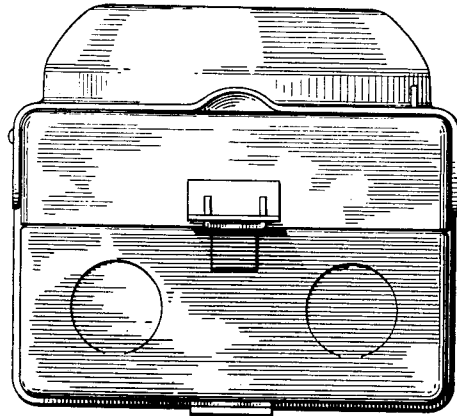

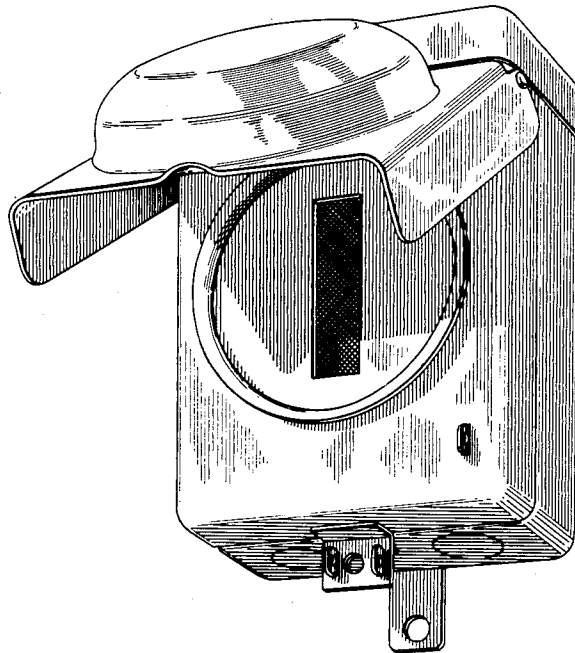
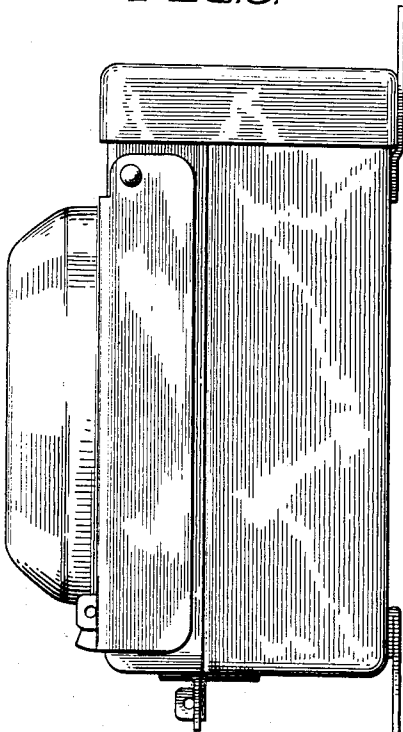

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Ralph M. Walker, a citizen of the United States and a resident of Atlanta, in the county of Fulton and State of Georgia, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Weatherproof Box for Electrical Devices, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming part thereof.

Figure 1 is a perspective view of a weather-

proof box for electrical devices, showing my new design,

Figure 2 is a bottom plan view thereof,

Figure 3 is a side elevational view,
