SUBJECT: Update of Automatic Garage Door and Garage Door Openers Entrapment Incidents to

Children under 15 Years of Age Reported to CPSC Between December 1, 1996 and

June 30, 2003

This memorandum provides information on automatic garage door and garage door opener entrapment incidents reported to CPSC between December 1, 1996 and June 30, 2003. This is an update to previous memorandums covering entrapment incidents reported to CPSC between March 1982 through November 30, 1996 (See Appendix Table A for list of previous memorandums and Appendices A-1 – A-4 for copies of the previous memorandums). Table 1 contains summary results from each memorandum. In A-1, the counts are of incidents that occurred since the previous memorandums were written. The incidents occurred in certain months not covered by the earlier memorandums. In A-2 and A-3, the counts are additional incidents as measured by the difference in the totals reported in the memorandums.

Between March 1982 and November 1996, there were 62 deaths and 49 injuries to children under 15 years of age associated with automatic garage doors and garage door openers. There were also 75 consumer complaints associated with potential entrapment hazards reported to CPSC during this period.

Injuries and Deaths from entrapment incidents reported to CPSC between December 1, 1996 and June 30, 2003

Between December 1, 1996 and June 30, 2003, there were 23 entrapment incidents involving death or injury with children under 15 years of age reported to CPSC. There were also 3 potential entrapment hazards during this period (in previous memorandums referred to as consumer complaints). The incidents occurred between 1989 and 2001. Table 2 contains summary information about the number of incidents that occurred and the type of incident (death, injury, or potential hazard). Potential hazards involve reports by consumers about problems with the products where no injury occurred.

Between August 1989 and November 1996, 12 entrapment injuries and no deaths to children under 15 years of age occurred, as reported to CPSC between December 1, 1996 and June 30, 2003. Between December 1996 and December 2001, 11 entrapment injuries (7) or deaths (4) occurred to children under 15 years of age as reported to CPSC. There were also 3 potential entrapment hazards reported by consumers. (See Table 3 attached for detailed information about the incidents listed in chronological order by date of occurrence, which were reported to CPSC between December 1, 1996 and June 30, 2003).

#### Date of Manufacture or Installation

Only 4 incidents had the date of manufacture/purchase in supporting documentation. One was manufactured post-1993 and one in 1994. The other two were purchased in 1995 and 1999. However, more details were available on date of installation (11 had information). Of these, 7 were installed in or after 1992. The remaining 4 were installed between the mid-1970s to 1988. The following table contains the installation date information.

Incidents related to malfunction of springs, reverse mechanisms, and sensor problems

At least 6 incidents involved problems with the spring. In 5 cases, the spring is reported to have broken and in 1 case the spring detached. Two deaths and 2 injuries were associated with broken springs. The 2 potential hazards were related to a broken spring and the spring detaching.

At least 5 incidents involved problems with the reverse mechanism failing. Two injuries and 2 deaths were caused by the reverse mechanism failing and closing on the injured child. In the other case, a consumer reported a potential hazard because the reverse mechanism did not function when a blockage occurred (no injuries occurred).

In 2 cases, the sensor electric eye was installed at an *improper* height of 21 inches resulting in 1 death and 1 injury. Sensors should be installed approximately 4-6 inches from the floor of the garage. In one of these cases, it was determined that the father had installed the sensor.

#### **UL Standards**

There were very few cases (4) in which the UL standard was mentioned. Three of the doors were compliant with the UL325 and 1 was compliant with UL196.

Subject: Automatic Garage Door Opener Entrapment Incidents,

January 1, 1991 Through November 1996.

This memorandum provides information on automatic garage door opener entrapment incidents reported to CPSC from 1991 through November 1996.

From 1991 through 1992, there were 10 entrapment incidents reported with children under 15 years old. Four involved a death and four involved injuries. The remaining two incidents involved a potential hazard where a person could have been injured or killed. From 1993 through November 1996, there were 25 entrapment incidents reported. Eight incidents involved a death where four victims were under 15 years old. Fourteen involved injury where 11 victims were under 15 years old. The remaining three incidents involved potential hazards.

None of the cases reported had information on whether the openers were manufactured after January 1, 1993.

A summary of the incidents reported is attached. The incidents are classified into three categories: deaths, injuries, and potential hazards, for 1991 through 1992 and 1993 through November 1996. They are listed in chronological order by date of incident.

In response to your request, this memorandum transmits two versions of the information on automatic garage door entrapment incidents received since the last update (November 25, 1992). One version includes information on the manufacturers for Compliance files and another version which is for public use excludes manufacturers.

From November 1, 1992 through May 31, 1995, CPSC received information on 27 additional entrapments, increasing the total number of entrapment incidents to 189 during March 1982 through May 1995. These incidents are classified into three categories: deaths (67), injuries (55), and complaints (67). All incidents reported to the Commission during this period are summarized in the attached table.

#### 1.Deaths

Since the last update seven entrapment deaths were reported; four of these deaths involved young children. The total number of entrapment deaths increased to 67 from March 1982 through May 1995. The incidents associated with the additional deaths are listed in chronological order by date of incident as follows:



Since June 30, 1992

This memorandum transmits information on automatic garage door incidents received since the last update (dated July 23, 1992), and covering the period March 1982 through June 30, 1992.

From July 1 through October 26, 1992, CPSC received information on 14 additional incidents. They involved essentially the same hazard scenarios as those reported earlier, and were classified into three categories: entrapment, non-entrapment and consumer complaints. All incidents reported to the Commission during the period March 1982 through October 26, 1992 are summarized in the attached table.

Since the July update, five entrapment deaths were reported; three of these deaths involved children 14 years of age and under. The total number of entrapment deaths for the period March 1982 through October 26, 1992, increased to 60 cases.

Six injuries were reported since the July update. Of the three entrapment injuries, one involved a child 14 years of age or under. There were three non-entrapment injuries; all were over 14 years of age. The total number of entrapment injuries for all ages increased to 47 cases and the total number of nonentrapment injuries increased to 26 cases.

In addition, three consumer complaints involving potential non-entrapment hazards were received, increasing the total number of consumer complaints to 106 cases (52 entrapment and 51 nonentrapment).

The following was prepared in response to your request for an update of incidents related to automatic garage door operators.

The national estimate for deaths involving automatic garage door operators was 94 deaths for the period from March 1982 through June 1992, or approximately 9 deaths per year. Seventy-five estimated deaths involved entrapment, when a descending automatic garage door failed to reverse upon contact. Among these estimated deaths, 69 involved young children, 2 to 14 years old, and 6 involved victims over 14 years of age. The Directorate for Epidemiology also estimated that 19 deaths involved non-entrapment incidents to all age groups (Table 1).

There were 66 injuries reported to CPSC during this time period; they were also categorized into two types, entrapment and non-entrapment. Thirty-six were entrapment injuries to victims 14 years old and younger, and 8 were entrapment injuries to victims over 14 years old. There were 22 non-entrapment injuries to all age groups (Attachment).

During this same period, there were 103 consumer complaints received by CPSC which involved potential hazards. These complaints involved 55 entrapment incidents and 48 non-entrapment incidents (Attachment).

The national estimate and its standard error was based on 69 reported deaths and determined by the Capture-Recapture method. A 95 percent confidence interval placed the number of automatic garage door operator related deaths between 74 and 114 deaths.
