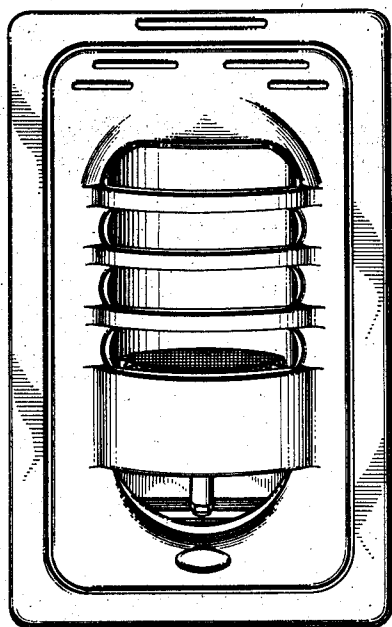

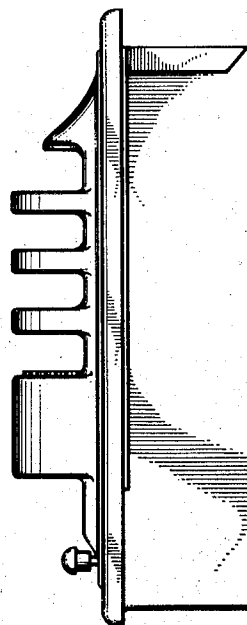

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Walter Baermann, a citizen of the United States, residing at Pasadena, in the county of Los Angeles, State of California, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for a Wall Heater or Similar Article, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawing, forming a part thereof.

Figure 1 is a front elevational view of a wall heater or similar article embodying my design.

Figure 2 is a side elevational view thereof.

The characteristic features of the design for a wall heater or similar article, reside in the convexly disposed webs on the central front portion thereof, having the configuration and arrangement substantially as shown.

I claim:

The ornamental design for a wall heater or similar article, substantially as shown and described.
